

Important information for testing week:

Start saving on your home internet with the Affordable Connectivity Program

Most Kentucky households with a student enrolled in public school qualify for a monthly discount on their home or mobile internet service through the <u>Affordable Connectivity Program</u> (ACP). The ACP is provided by the Federal Communications Commission to support student success. KDE encourages all eligible households to claim this benefit and start saving on your internet service.

You may be able to save:

- Up to \$30/month on your new or existing internet service, and/or
- a one-time discount up to \$100 for the purchase of a tablet, laptop, or desktop computer.

Chances are you qualify!

At least 80% of Kentucky households with students enrolled in public schools are eligible for ACP benefits. Here are the ways you can qualify:

- your child/dependent is enrolled in a school participating in the Community Eligibility Program where all students receive free- or reduced-price meals,
- you or your child/dependent participate in government assistance programs such as SNAP,
 Medicaid, Free or Reduced-price School Lunch Program, or other programs.
- household income is 200% or less than the <u>Federal Poverty Guidelines</u>, or
- anyone in your household already receives a Lifeline benefit.
- If you still have questions about if you qualify, please visit the <u>Do I Qualify ACP webpage for</u> specifics.

Public Health Emergency Unwinding

Kentucky Medicaid Renewals

Here is what you need to know to stay covered!

If you or a family member currently has health coverage through Medicaid or the Kentucky Children's Health Insurance Program, called KCHIP, there are changes coming.

What's changing?

Because of COVID-19, the federal government declared a public health emergency (PHE). During this time, changes were made so that Medicaid and KCHIP renewals were not required, so people did not lose their coverage.

However, Kentucky will restart Medicaid annual renewals April 1, 2023. Make sure you take the necessary steps to keep your coverage!



🔭 You will receive a letter when it is your time to renew.

What do you need to do?

Update your information: Make sure kynect.ky.gov

has your correct:

- mailing address
- phone number
- email

This way, we can contact you without delay.

Check your mail:

You will get a letter about your Medicaid or KCHIP renewal when it is your **time**. The letter will let you know if you need to complete a form or send in information to keep your coverage.


If you get a form, fill it out, return it right away. Make sure to give us any information we request. The information will help determine if you still qualify for coverage.





G-FORCE

A support program for grieving youth

Gravity. It grounds us. It holds us in orbit. It helps us stay centered. It pulls against us when rocketing into the stratosphere. Grief works much the same way. G-Force refers to the pull of gravity when making a transition forward. It takes practice and conditioning to withstand the pressure and to adapt. So does grief. We are not helpless in the face of loss. We can become stronger, more resilient, and confident that we can do hard things.

G-FORCE is a peer-centered education, support, and networking opportunity for youth coping with loss due to death. Meetings occur throughout the year offering a cycle every fall and spring following the school calendar. Youth can join at any point and re-up in an upcoming cycle.

G-FORCE meets at the Hosparus Health Grief Counseling Center 3526 Ephraim McDowell Drive, Louisville, 40205

For youth in grades 6 through 10

Fall 2022: Every 1st and 3rd Thursday, 4:30 – 6 p.m. September 1 through December 15

Spring 2023: Every 2nd and 4th Thursday, 4:30 – 6 p.m. February 9 – April 27

For youth in grades 2 through 5

Fall 2022: Every 1st and 3rd Friday, 4:30 – 6 p.m. September 2 through December 16

Spring 2023: Every 2nd and 4th Friday, 4:30 – 6 p.m. February 10 – April 28
