The school's professional development plan to reach our achievement gaps includes training's in Empower Learning Management Systems, Implementation of the Literacy & Numeracy Playground (to provide interventions), Competency Based Education, Project Based Learning, Universal Design for Learning Session, ELL Learning Strategies focus on Language Discourse Objectives, and Early Math. Painted Stone Elementary is a school family focused on the mission of Loving Each Other, Learning Together, and Leading the Way! Our enrollment is comprised of 546 students. Our current enrollment is 28% Hispanic/Latino, 4% two or more races, 5% African American and 60% White. 293 students are males, 253 students are females. Approximately 49% of our school is free/reduced lunch. Our school is part of the CEP program in which all of our students receive free breakfast and lunch even if they are not eligible for free/reduced meals. The communities in which we serve are the city of Shelbyville and around the bypass area of Shelby County, including rural outlying areas going towards Oldham County, Kentucky. Our school is located in Northern-Western Shelby County right off of the Shelbyville bypass called "Freedoms Way" by Shelby West Middle School. Shelby County's population is 47,421. The city of Shelbyville's population is 15,872. In the past three school years, our school has had an administration change. PSE received a new Principal, Vice Principal and Counselor during the 2015-2016 school year. This is third school year of the new administration. New vision and mission have been implemented and carried out. Also, initiatives with character coins and schoolwide teams are continuing to shape and mold our culture in our school family. Schoolwide morning meetings are the norm on a weekly basis. A student voice team is in place. The culture and climate in our building continues on an upward trajectory. Some unique challenges that our school is presented with is our large population of Hispanic/Latino students and meeting their needs. Many of our students enter our school with little to no English language experience. This can be very challenging to meet their needs. In addition to the existing challenges, our free and reduced lunch rate is also another factor to consider. As of lately, the number of students residing in the homes of their grandparents, or other relatives other than their biological parents has also increased. While faced with these challenges, Painted Stone Elementary loves all students no matter their circumstances and promotes an environment where we focus on the student as a whole and where families and guests feel welcomed. We are kids first, kids second, and all others come next.

When students enter the campus they are greeted with signs in the front lobby. The school mission is chanted every morning that speaks of loving, learning and leading the way as students go about their day. When

students are sent to the office, they often reflect on how they could love, learn and lead. Students are encouraged to love, learn and lead through their schoolwide teams, composed of Team Tenacity, Team Encouragement, Team Achievement, and Team Motivation. Students are on teams beginning in kindergarten and remain on that team throughout their elementary school tenure at PSE. The teams meet together on Fridays for Reading buddies and team events, in addition to our weekly Friday schoolwide morning meeting. A team is celebrated when they earned the most character coins for the week and their banner is hung on display for all to see. In addition to character coins, we have added a new and exciting element by highlighting those students that are truly living out our school mission on a daily basis by putting them to a vote to earn a PSE Character Coat (an elementary type lettermen jacket) Other ways that students celebrated for learning, leading and loving is through our Drama, Art Club, Random Acts of Kindness club, Environmental Club, WPSE News and The Student Voice Team. We expect every student to love each other, learn together and lead the way.

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Notable Achievements and Areas of Improvement
