



P-EBT Applications Open 8/7 for Most Eligible Students

Public and private school students can apply Aug. 7; Homeschool and virtual students can apply Sept. 4

P-EBT provides a reimbursement to households with students that attended school in-person, virtually or through homeschool and had any COVID-19 related school absences between Sept. 1, 2022, and May 11, 2023. This reimbursement is meant to cover the cost of at-home food purchases made because the student was unable to participate in school learning due to a COVID-19 related reason.

The benefit amount varies for each approved student due to the number of days missed. The daily amount for each school day missed is \$8.18.

The application will roll out in phases. The first application phase begins Aug. 7: Beginning Aug. 7, public and private school students who received free or reduced price meals at school AND were absent from school one or more days due to COVID, may apply for P-EBT for the days missed. The applicant will need the student's State Student Identification Number (SSID), dates of school days missed for COVID-related reasons for Sept 1, 2022, through May 11, 2023, and other personal identifying information for the student.

Beginning Sept. 4, homeschool students and students who attended school virtually may apply for benefits. The applicant will need the student's personal identifying information and, if a benefit recipient, the household's case number. Applicants may also need household financial information to complete the application for homeschool and virtual students.

Parents must apply at https://www.kypebt.ky.gov/ to determine if their child is eligible for a reimbursement.

Summer P-EBT

Enrollment in Summer P-EBT is automatic for public and private school students who received free/reduced-price meals during May 2023.

SNAP recipients under age 6 (aka Child Care P-EBT), homeschool, and virtual students are not eligible due to the end of the federal Public Health Emergency on May 11, 2023.

To receive the \$200 payment for your time, you must attend the entire fifteen-hour training. If you miss a portion of the training, we will schedule a time with you to make it up. If you are unable to make up the missed portion, you will receive \$10 per hour based on the time attended. If you complete the entire fifteen-hours, you will receive \$10 per hour = \$150 + \$50 bonus for finishing!



SUMMER SUBSIDY

LIHEAP & LIHWAP JULY 25 - SEPTEMBER 22, 2023

Funding provided by Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services through block grant from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.



SUBSIDY DETAILS

LIHEAP and LIHWAP are designed to assist eligible Kentucky households with their electric, water, and/or wastewater bills.

Summer Subsidies DO NOT require a disconnect notice, a past due bill or eviction notices. The Subsidy benefit can be applied as a credit on your account.

Documentation required at time of application:

- Proof of Social Security Number or Permanent Residence card (Green Card) for each member of the household.
- Proof of all household's (all members) income from the preceding month.
- Current electric and/or water service bill, or statement from your landlord if they are included in your rent, or statement from utility company if you participate in a Pre-Pay.

Programs are open to all income eligible households, please see income chart below for eligibility guidelines.

COMPONENT DETAILS

Households can apply for one or both programs, and benefit is paid directly to the household's vendor. Past program assistance does not affect eligibility.

Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis starting July 25, 2023, through September 22, 2023, or until designated funds have been expended.

LIHWAP

Water and/or Wastewater

Benefit: One-time water service benefit, ranging from \$50 to \$100, depending on housing category.

Households must be responsible for their home water service cost.

LIHEAP

Electric

Benefit: One-time electric benefit, ranging from \$50 to \$250, depending on income and housing category.

Households must be responsible for their home electric cost.

Start saving on your home internet with the Affordable Connectivity Program

Most Kentucky households with a student enrolled in public school qualify for a monthly discount on their home or mobile internet service through the <u>Affordable Connectivity Program</u> (ACP). The ACP is provided by the Federal Communications Commission to support student success. KDE encourages all eligible households to claim this benefit and start saving on your internet service.

You may be able to save:

- Up to \$30/month on your new or existing internet service, and/or
- a one-time discount up to \$100 for the purchase of a tablet, laptop, or desktop computer.

Chances are you qualify!

At least 80% of Kentucky households with students enrolled in public schools are eligible for ACP benefits. Here are the ways you can qualify:

- your child/dependent is enrolled in a school participating in the Community Eligibility Program
 where all students receive free- or reduced-price meals,
- you or your child/dependent participate in government assistance programs such as SNAP,
 Medicaid, Free or Reduced-price School Lunch Program, or other programs.
- · household income is 200% or less than the Federal Poverty Guidelines, or
- anyone in your household already receives a Lifeline benefit.

Public Health Emergency Unwinding

Kentucky Medicaid Renewals

Here is what you need to know to stay covered!

If you or a family member currently has health coverage through Medicaid or the Kentucky Children's Health Insurance Program, called KCHIP, there are changes coming.

What's changing?

Because of COVID-19, the federal government declared a public health emergency (PHE). During this time, changes were made so that Medicaid and KCHIP renewals were not required, so people did not lose their coverage.

However, Kentucky will restart Medicaid annual renewals April 1, 2023. Make sure you take the necessary steps to keep your coverage!



🔭 You will receive a letter when it is your time to renew.

What do you need to do?

Update your information: Make sure kynect.ky.gov

has your correct:

- mailing address
- phone number
- email

This way, we can contact you without delay.

Check your mail:

You will get a letter about your Medicaid or KCHIP renewal when it is your **time**. The letter will let you know if you need to complete a form or send in information to keep your coverage.

Send in information:

If you get a form, fill it out, return it right away. Make sure to give us any information we request. The information will help determine if you still qualify for coverage.

Kentucky Medicaid will reach out to you when it is your time to renew.


