Plan: Plan out your ideas, determine what you know and what you want to find out. Form 3-4 guiding questions. 2. Search: Use any resources you have available to find information about your topic. They can be print or digital sources, just make sure they are credible. 3. Take Notes: Gather information from your sources while you are reading organized by your guiding questions. Be sure to cite sources along the way. 4. Use the information: Determine which pieces of information from your notes are most important and accurate. 5. Write: Put your information together into a writing piece that shares your research. If time allows, create a slideshow to display your research.
