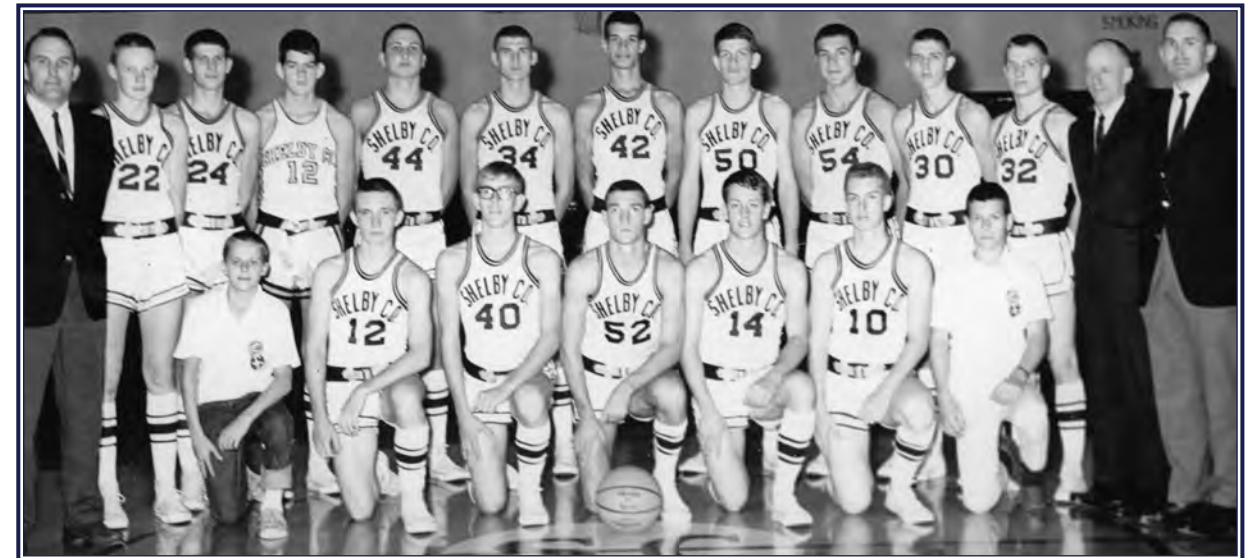

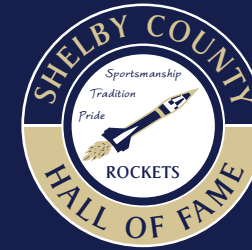


Arnold Thurman

- Physical Education teacher at Shelby County High School from 1960-1979.
- Athletic Director from 1968-1979, during which time the athletic program won state championships in baseball, boys basketball, and boys track and field.
- Assistant basketball coach on 1966 State Basketball Championship team; head coach of the 1966 freshman basketball team.
- Former Head Track and Field coach (girls and boys).
- Established Cross Country team (1960).
- Assistant Football coach from 1962-1965.

Coach Thurman passed away in May of 2015. He is survived by his wife Jeanette, sons Doug, Chuck and Tom, and his five grandchildren.

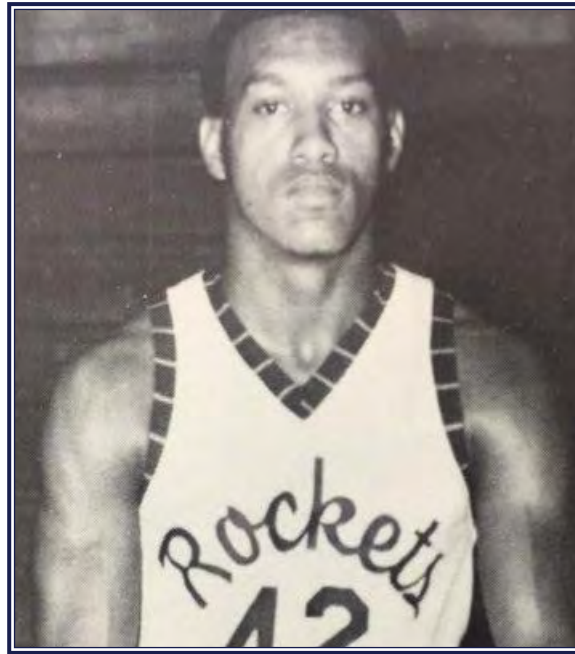

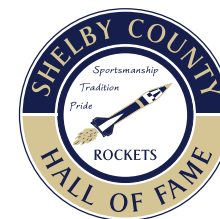

- Named twice to the All-State Tournament team in 1977 and 1978
- Attended Morehead State University on a basketball scholarship
- Led the OVC in single season steals while at Morehead
- Scored over 1200 points for his career while at Morehead
- Coached 3 seasons on the Shelby Co. Rocket basketball staff
- Was the head coach at Cornerstone Christian Academy for 2 seasons where he won the State Christian Championship his first season
- Was assistant basketball coach at Martha Layne Collins for 5 seasons

Norris and his longtime wife, Teretha are the proud parents of 2 boys (Norris "Boomer" Beckley, Jr and Richard LaShon Beckley). Norris continues to work for the Shelby County Public School System. He is a committed Christian and remains active in the Shelby Co. community.



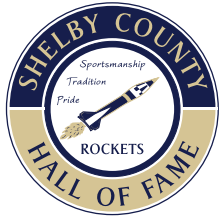

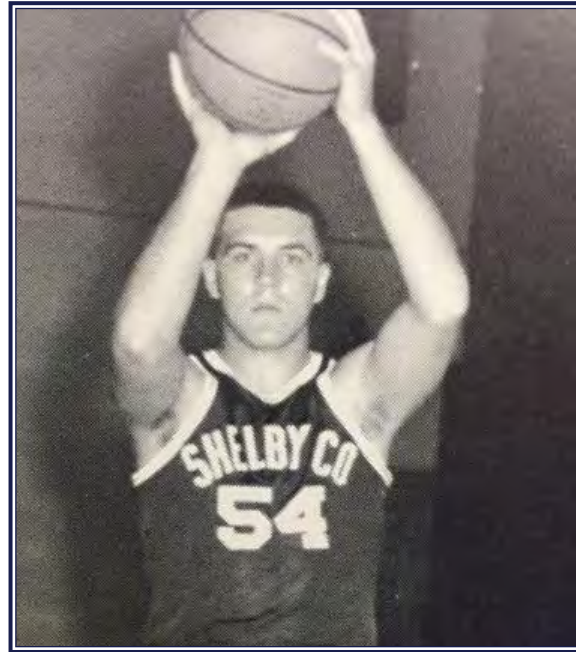
Janice Stone Littlejohn

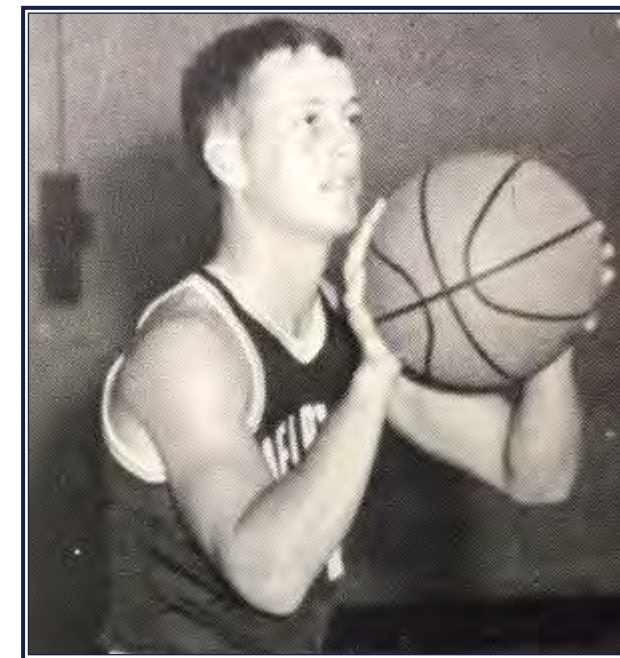
Ron Ritter

- 1967 Drafted by Pittsburg Pirates in first round - 13th Overall
- State Runner-Up in Baseball in 1966
- 2 Sport Athlete in Basketball and Baseball
- Named to the KY Softball Hall of Fame in 1990
- As a member of the Jiffy Club squad he was named to the All World Tournament Team in 1967
- Won several MVP and home run awards
- Won over 600 games as pitcher and hit over 2000 home runs
