Student Athlete Expectations

Academics

MCM/ MLCH SBDM grade policy for student athletes is strictly enforced. Any student who has one or more F's on his, or her progress report, or report card during the full season (spring, summer, or fall) will be suspended indefinitely until progress is shown. Progression is completely to Coach King's discretion.

Behavior

Student athletes will follow in accordance with MCM/ Collins behavior policy for athletes.

- Players should always conduct themselves as young men and women on the field, at school, and in public.
- Use good manners and always be respectful. Players should never want to embarrass themselves, family, teammates, community, or coaches, and always represent MCM with honor and good behavior.
- No weapons, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or any electronic gadgets used to smoke are allowed, and prohibited. There are NO EXCEPTIONS!! A violation of this rule is an automatic dismissal from the team and further investigation may follow.
- Detention and behavior problems in school will not be tolerated. Coach King will deal with the issues depending on the severity of the problem.
- Out of school suspension will result in automatic dismissal from the team!

- Dress neatly in accordance to school dress code policy which includes piercings, tattoos, hair, etc. Proper appearance will be to Coach King's discretion.

Practice AND GAME GUIDELINES

- All PRACTICES ARE CLOSED! (Let's all be mindful of each other. Parents can watch, not coach!)
- No parent or guardian will be permitted on the field during practices or games. (Video and pictures from the stands, unless it's after the game.)
- Parents if you are asked to leave a practice or game, just leave! If not, the school administrator and/ or proper authority will be notified.
- Attendance, all players are expected to arrive on time and be an active participant at all times. If a football function is to be missed, it must be cleared directly with Coach King. Being cleared is at coach's discretion. Violation and discipline is at the coach's discretion. Please do your best not to schedule appointments during practices or games.
- There is no parent contact with players during the game or practice. Coach King is available for emergencies.
- If a player is sick or has an injury, Coach King must be informed ASAP. Players are not cleared from a practice unless a doctor approves your absence. Please do not try to self- diagnose.
- Three things players, coaches, and parents can not control are: referees, the other team, and the weather. Let's all be respectful and not complain about any of them.
- No concession stands ran during games/ slash practices, unless it's planned with Coach King.
- Be positive at all times and encourage our kids!!!
- NO PROFANITY!!! (Players/ Parents)

Equipment Guidelines

- Make sure personal equipment is taken care of and team equipment is BETTER taken care of.
- All school issued equipment is to be stored neatly and kept well maintained. Each player will be responsible for cleaning up and storing equipment after practices and games.
- All uniforms and clothing is to be kept clean and unaltered.
- All school issued equipment is expected to be returned on the date required by Coach King.
- If equipment is not returned, parents will be billed for the cost of the missing equipment. Cash or check will be accepted.

Travel Guidelines

- Home games and practices will be held at Collins Stadium.
- All pregame meals will be discussed before the season begins.
- Proper equipment on game day is required. No equipment/ No uniform = No Game! No EXCEPTIONS. COME PREPARED!
- All busses will leave from the school. All players must ride the bus there and back! (Subject to change, players can be signed out on the way home. Must see Coach King)
- After each game, players may take their equipment home that night and return with it the next morning to school! NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Coach King has the authority to have all players ride home on the bus after away games.

PARENT GUIDELINES

- There will be no discussion of playing time, game strategy, or other players on the team. NO EXCEPTIONS!

- Meetings will only take place after Coach King has been contacted, two or more coaches will be present. All school issued equipment must be present at the meeting.
- Meetings will never take place on a game day or during a practice unless it's an emergency.
- Parents are asked not to criticize the referees, coaches and other players.
- Parents are expected to notify Coach King of all illnesses, appointments, injuries, etc.
- Please refrain from coaching from the stands.
- Parents should conduct themselves in an orderly fashion as not to embarrass yourselves, child, school, or community.

All policies, rules, and guidelines will be strictly enforced. If any situation, or matter occurs MCM/ Collins extracurricular policies and guidelines will be enforced. Any matter pertaining to the MCM Football Program is to Coach Derrel King's discretion! Thank You!
