Three Year Old Options

- 2 Days a week: Tuesday and Thursday and the monthly fee is \$145.
- 3 Days a week: Monday, Wednesday, and Friday and the monthly fee is \$170.

Four Year Old Options

- 3 Days a week: Monday, Wednesday, and Friday and the monthly fee is \$170.
- 5 Days a week: Monday-Friday and the monthly fee is \$210.

Dorman Center Preschool is a non-profit 501 (c) charitable, educational agency. The center began in 1964 serving 6 children with disabilities. The first class was held at 205 9th Street, which was re-opened as our second location, in 2003, serving children until it was purchased by the Shelby County Board of Education in 2012. We continue to serve children with disabilities and at risk and in 2010 we began providing inclusive education; providing preschool and child care for any child aged 6 weeks to 5 years.

What it means to be Kindergarten ready...

- Letter identification
- Letter sounds
- Writing his/her name
- Counting to 30
- Counting items from 1 to 10 (by touching one at a time)
- Can hold a pencil and scissors appropriately
- Can put on and take off their coat

You're on your way to K!

The transition to kindergarten is respected as a major milestone not only for the child, but for his or her family as well. The attitude towards school and learning that the child carries with them for life is often determined by this very first experience with school. A smooth transition to kindergarten can help make sure your child is successful in school.

The information provided below is designed to help you prepare your children for their school experience.

You bet, I'm ready for K!

Personal Needs Without help, can they...

- ___ Put on and take off coat
- ___ Tie their own shoes
- ___ Wash their hands
- ___ Snap, button, zip, and buckle

Social Skills Can they...

- ___ Listen to an adult & follow simple instructions
- ___ Cooperate with other children
- ___ Sit for short periods of time
- ___ Follow simple two-step directions

Intellectual Skills Do your children...

- ___ Sit and listen to a story
- ___ Hold a book upright and turn the pages
- ___ Know their first and last name
- ___ Tell and retell familiar stories
- ___ Know colors, shapes and sizes
- ___ Counts 0-10

Intellectual Skills (continued)

- ___ Saying the ABC's
- ___ Holds scissors & pencil appropriately
- ___ Recognizes and writes first name (remember-use capital letter for the first letter in a name.) M-o-t-t, not M-A-T-T
- ___ Recognizes the letters within their name

To help with a smooth transition into kindergarten you can follow these additional helpful ideas, provide opportunities to play with other children, teach your children socially acceptable ways to disagree, and encourage social values such as helpfulness, cooperation, sharing and concern for others.
