

Laura Beth Floyd Allison Memorial Scholarship

Description:

Given in memory of a young lady who loved Shelby County and the farm where she grew up. While living on the farm, she developed a strong work ethic, a willingness to help family and community, and an independent and adventurous spirit.

Applicants for the \$1000 scholarship should display some traits similar to Beth: independence, love of life, strong work ethic, love of family, and integrity.

The recipient will be determined by a scholarship committee of community members. The readers of the essay will not know the names of the applicants. Interviews may be held at the discretion of the committee.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Student must exhibit a good work ethic, integrity, and compassion.
- Student must be pursuing a degree in agriculture,
- Student may be pursuing higher education through a community college or a four-year college.
- Student must be in top 25% of the S.C.H.S. senior class according to GPA.
- Student must complete attached application and an essay of 300-350 words explaining why you should be considered for this scholarship. (Include two to three traits you share with Beth.)

- Student must submit one letter of recommendation from someone other than a family member.

Timeline:

- Applications will be available April 8, 2019.
- Applications will be due May 1, 2019.
- If an interview is required, you will be notified by Ms. Shiver.

Distribution of Scholarship:

- A check for \$500 will be issued during Senior Awards Night in May.
- The remaining \$500 will be mailed to the recipient following receipt of transcript and second semester class schedule if cumulative GPA is 2.5 or above for the first semester.

Note: Failure to send a transcript and second semester class schedule to the designated individual can lead to loss of remaining scholarship. An address will be provided.
